Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Find and read a book by our author of the term- Maz Evans.	Design a new book cover for the story The Last Garden by Racheil Ip
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Play a verbal game with someone at home i.e. I spy, when Grandma went shopping, The alphabet game.	Practice saying different colours in French. Can you learn a song about colours in French?
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Can you find some coins and notes at home and practicing counting money. Can you find some change? Can you create a shop and practice adding money together?	Practice your 10 times table. Find objects around the house and place them in groups of 10.  '3 groups of 10= 30' '3 x 10 = 30'
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Research the stone age and create a poster, presentation, leaflet or book.	Write a story about a stone age child and some adventures they go on. Can you add your own illustrations too.
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Try creating a winter or seasons collage. Use scraps of paper, bits of recycling to create your picture. STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Can you write a recipe book with different healthy recipes in? Maybe include some photos of what the food should look like.	Can you research a scientist who looks at rocks (geology) for their job. You could create a poster of fact file about your significant scientist.
Living in the wider world (RE & PSHE)	We are Citizens and Role Models!	Explore another religion and what they believe about God. Try Islam, Hinduism or Judaism.	Create a poster/ sign for a child in Year 1 about how to keep themselves safe outside, at home, in strange places.
